- 1. Start reading the Bible today -there is no better time, and there's no reason to wait.
- 2. Set aside a specific time each day. Set your schedule and then stick to it. Mornings are great, but feel free to use any time that works consistently for you.
- 3. Remember to pray before you begin to read, asking the Holy Spirit to open your eyes and your heart to what He wants to teach you.
- 4. Consider keeping a small notebook handy to jot down anything that sticks out to you, or questions you have while you are reading.
